Bar Mitzvah Policies

- The date of the bar mitzvah needs to be within 5 years from the date that the family wants the bar mitzvah. It has to be after the boy's 8th birthday as long as the bar mitzvah date is within the 5 year timeframe.
- The office will get back to the parents in a week's time from when they called. That way it gives a family whose son has a Bo Bayom that same week to call in. The boy with the Bo Bayom would get the Bar Mitzvah. If there are 2 boys with the same Bo Bayom, then it goes by seniority.
- Shabbat Shuva is a date that is now available to book for a Bar Mitzvah.
 - Parents should be aware that there is an additional fee for using the Soc. Hall for take down of the Rosh Hashanah & Yom Kippur set up. Also, depending on how the chagim fall out, using the Soc. Hall might not be an option. The same would apply to Shabbat Hagadol.
 - Shabbat Shuva Haftarah goes to the Rabbi. The families of a bar mitzvah boy should be aware of this if they choose to book Shabbat Shuva.
- If a boy is born in a regular Adar, and his bar mitzvah falls in a leap year, the reservation would be made in Adar II
